### Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

The project has three components. 1.) The After School Enrichment Program (ASE) at Piyali Learning Center is designed to provide students with the opportunity to participate in co-curricular activities in arts, athletics and life skills. The purpose is to keep the students physically safe during the most vulnerable evening hours, as well as develop communication, teamwork, and leadership skills. ASE serves approximately 55 students from Class 6<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup>. Athletic equipment purchased with grant funds will provide value for an undetermined duration. Funding for instructors, snacks and field trips is expected to last seven months. 2.) Mukta, is the name of PLC's women's empowerment program. It provides literacy and vocational training in tailoring and jewelry making. Mukta – Tailoring Training serves approximately 30 trainees per year. The five "double" sewing machines, two large work tables, and ten work trays purchased with grant funds will provide value for an undetermined duration. 3.) Panchayat Elementary has 31 students in classes from 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup>. Grant funds were used to construct a compound wall and gate needed to keep the elephants away from the school property and to safeguard the children and the school.

2. How many people benefited from this project? 116 directly

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?  
The students, and village women directly impacted benefit from a richer, safer, and more effective learning environment. The local families also benefit in related ways.

4. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Approx. 12 directly

5. What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project.  
Four Rotarians from SDDDB (5340) traveled to the project sites to perform needs assessments and completion assessments. Four Rotarians from Calcutta Metropolitan provided needs assessments, facilitated the procurement of equipment and instructors, and provided receipts. Four Rotarians from Coimbatore provided needs assessments, facilitated the procurement of construction, and provided receipts.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?  
Independent instructors and construction workers were hired.


