We provided \$3,000 to the Grapevine Police Department to meet small immediate needs of people, especially children, in Grapevine. E.g. A boy received a backpack to carry school supplies; a family of 5 were found sleeping in their hot car, had no money, no food. The police officer took them to MacDonalds, got them a motel for the night and gave them gas money to get home in Oklahoma.

 Helped to design and fund this grant; Promoted this to other civic organizations and the fund has more than doubled in size. We expect this to be a permanent fund.
