Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Three \$1,500 scholarships were awarded to graduating seniors to pursue the Associate's degree at Tarrant County College. Students were recruited with the help of the principals and staffs at Polytechnic, Dunbar and Wyatt high schools. Approximately 15 students participated in initial interviews. Six (two from each school) were selected for finalist interviews, which were held on April 27, 2016. Three scholars were named and they participated in Fort Worth East Scholars Orientation with TCC faculty and staff as well as their assigned Club mentors on Wednesday, May 18, 2016.

Club members participated in the setup of the agreement with TCC, the development and review of applications, semifinalists and finalist interview, planning and execution of the scholars' orientation, and assigning and serving as mentors.

- * These three scholars will be eligible for and \$1,500 scholarship through the TCC Foundation in their second year

- * These scholars and their families stand to benefit from the increased earning potential that earning an Associate's degree affords the average TCC graduate to more than double their family income from \$17,000 to \$40,000/year.
