



The Solana Beach ECO Rotary Sanitation Project is building five latrines for poor Cambodia rural families in the Kos Khel region, where there's a serious lack of decent toilet facilities. This causes contamination of streams and soils, which leads to the spread of disease, high rates of infant and young child mortality, and heavy caseloads of diarrhea and other infections. The latrines we fund are a "double-pit" system with an attached ceramic squatting base surrounded by a simple enclosure, which is erected with the help of the families receiving the latrine. In the photos we see the first latrine being constructed.
