2. Name of District Grant : Vocational Training
3. Briefly describe the grant and list any changes that might have occurred (100 words or less. The grant was to provide impoverished communities with access to vocational training; in the construction industry. Areas of focus include: Advanced Masonry, Carpentry, Plumbing, and Electrical Skills. The community center in an extremely impoverished neighborhood of El Florido Section IV was found to be the best candidate for this venture. In conjunction with the Build A Miracle foundation the training has commenced and continues to grow. Although women were never discriminated in planning of this type of vocational training, we had imagined that our target for students were going to be young men. We were pleasantly surprised to find that the majority of students that registered and had put a great deal of effort were the women. We have found that in these impoverished neighborhoods women are many times single mothers and are the primary income for the families. A group of the carpentry students, all women, have even formed a co-op and through social media have marketed their new trade. By building cabinets and household items they can now sell those items and services throughout Tijuana.

Provide a brief (100 words or less) of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded projects: In choosing to fund this grant it is important to support a self-sustaining project, we never did we imagine for it to flourish like this. The power that giving ownership to the people we intend to help is vital. It did not only allow for synergy among the Rotary Club of Lemon Grove and BAM foundation but most importantly the community we choose to help. We felt that vibe, or saw that type of environment when deciding to help that specific community center. We felt the drive that the community has as a whole to better themselves that of their neighbor, unity is key. The women who never saw themselves more than moms and wives have now shown to be true community leaders and constituents of their local government.

Rotary Club Grant Update – Construction Classes
August 17, 2013

As of August, 2013, we have initiated the weekend Construction Classes that will include Carpentry, Masonry, Electrical and Plumbing. We have begun to plan and prepare a space for the 5th area, Welding.

To date we have spent approximately \$1,000 on materials and \$900 on teachers for the construction classes. Because we believe that the Welding Class will offer the greatest benefit in terms of improving employment and employability, we are carefully planning the purchases of equipment and supplies while we build the workshop where these classes will be held. We are currently using welding equipment on loan free of charge to do some very preliminary projects, but will not do serious training until the electrical installations and workshop are complete.
