The project will bring drinking water to families that did not have it before. This will benefit 45 to 50 families, each family around 5 to 6 members

Since 2006, a delegation from the Rotary Club of Steamboat Springs has traveled every year with teenagers from our Interact Club to meet with the Rotary Club of Agua Prieta to do service projects, including painting at a school, and working in orphanages. We have provided grant money in the past to install water tanks and plumbing at schools and orphanages and provided grant money to purchase a water pump for the Brazos De Amor orphanage. We have seen all the projects completed with the Rotary Logo prominently displayed on the tanks and documented with receipts. The two clubs have enjoyed the fellowship we have shared over the years, and the projects have had a profound impact on the teenagers from the Interact Club. Mr Hammond of Steamboat Springs has been on many of these trips and has become personal friends with several members of the Agua Prieta Rotary Club, including the project director Marco Sanchez.
