Project Title: \_Water Project in Agua Prieta, Mexico

**Project Description:**

1. **Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place? Who were the beneficiaries?** This project involved the purchase, distribution and in some cases installation of 1000 liter water tanks (55) in homes without water. The project will benefit 50 families, each with 5 – 6 family members, by providing them with drinking water. In some cases, the families have been without water for up to 4 years. The project took place in Agua Prieta, Sonora, Mexico.
2. **How many Rotarians participated in this project?** 10 Rotarians from Steamboat Springs, 13 Rotarians from Rotario Agua Prieta and 8 Interact students from Steamboat Springs High School participated.
3. **What did they do? Please give at least two examples.**

Rotarians placed Rotary stickers (Steamboat Springs Rotary Club) onto the 55 tanks (Rotario Agua Prieta stickers were already placed on tanks.

Rotarians and Interact students and the Mayor of Agua Prieta visited 5 families who already had the purchased tanks installed. We took photos and spoke with the families.

In addition, we participated in the distribution of 50 tanks to a specific community in need. Community members had vouchers for the tanks and were able to roll them home!

Our trip to Agua Prieta also included work on a school (Por Los Ninos), a visit and gifts to an assisted living center and an orphanage, and childrens gifts to extremely poor neighborhoods, though these activities were not part of our District Grant funding.

4. **How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?** About 275 – 300.

5. **What is the expected long-term community impact of this project?**

The water tanks are expected to be in place for many years (they require no upkeep) enabling the families to have water over the long term.

6. **If a cooperating organization was involved, what was their role?** Mayor of Agua Prieta's office provided media coverage.

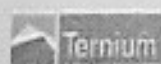
