The Dining Room Acoustics Project will modify the acoustics of the Dining Room of the Senior Center (830 E. Hanson Ave., Jackson, WY) to make it more senior friendly. The project will purchase and install three folding room dividers in the openings between the main Dining Room and the North Dining/Activities Room. This will accomplish two goals: 1) separate the high ceiling main dining room from the smaller, low ceiling section of the North Dining Room to mitigate the reverberation making hearing difficult; 2) allow two activities to be held in the Dining Room space at the same time to optimize socialization opportunities for seniors.
