Project Description:		

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place? Who were the beneficiaries?

Three accordion divider doors were installed at the Senior Center of Jackson Hole to separate the high ceiling main dining room from the smaller, low ceiling section of the North Dining Room. Significant reworking of the openings was required to accommodate the weight of the doors. There has been a great improvement to the acoustics of the room and flexibility of spaces that has benefited the approximately 1,570 seniors who attend annually.

- 3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Rotarians participated in the writing of the grant and fund raising from the club. Rotarians supported the Senior Center throughout the project by attending the Center, serving dinner, talking with people about the project and monitoring the progress of the project.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 1570

The accordion doors have made such a significant improvement in the sound and flexibility of the space that all seniors who attend the Senior Center for meals and events have benefited.

5. What is the expected long-term community impact of this project?

The modification to the dining room space will be a lasting, long-term improvement to both the acoustics and the usability of the dining room for events and classes. The Senior Center is now able to schedule more events and classes for seniors.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was their role?

The Senior Center of Jackson Hole took the lead in selecting the product and working with the contractors in completing the project.

- Cover with two layers of 5/8" fire code drywall.
- Tape and mud, three coats, let dry between coats, texture both sides to match.
- Paint two coats to match all surfaces as before.



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
