1.	1. Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place? Who were the beneficiaries?				
	The Student Recovery program is a skill recovery for Hispanic males at Greeley Central High school in Greeley, CO. These students enroll in a rigorous summer school program between the 9 th and 10 th grade to takes courses they may have failed in the previous academic year. The program continues to work with these students during the next three years to help them graduate. The program is also designed to provide the students with vocational and life training skills. The Greeley Rotary Club partnered with the Student Recovery Program to assist with purchasing supplies and conducting the 4 Way Test program with Hispanic males in a local high school.

3.	What did they do? Please give at least two examples.				
	Rotarians helped by donating monies to the project to purchase the supplies for the students. They also conducted a 4Way test with the students at Greeley Central High School. Two of the high school counselors also brought a few of the students to a Rotary meeting to meet some of the members and learn about the vocations of those members.

The Student Recovery Program achieves an 85% graduation rate among a population that typically graduates about 50-60% of their students. Over 90% of graduates are gainfully employed and contributing positively to our city.

We had some difficulty getting the 4 Way test scheduled with the school due to their schedule. We will continue to work with the counselors to get future 4 Way test programs scheduled.

The Student Recovery Program provided a program to our Rotary Club where they shared an overview of the program, the costs, its successes and how our club was involved. This project has been highlighted in the local newspaper and has information on a website.

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
