Speaker brings positive message to Estes Park students

Two assemblies funded by three Rotary clubs

With puns and self-deprecating humor, Jerry Traylor delivered his very serious message to Estes Park students in Grades 6-12 on Oct. 30.

After meeting U.S. presidents and appearing countless times in the national media, Traylor counts his time with students as his most important. He emphasized that the years students are in middle and high school shape their opportunities for the future.

"Graduation is not the finish line. It's actually the starting line," he said.

Traylor encouraged students to look into their hearts and souls and to embrace what makes them unique, to seek supportive friends, and to strive for excellence, not perfection, which is unobtainable.

"Find out who you are and really, really build that person," he told the high school students gathered in the auditorium. "Don't worry about what you lack."

Born with cerebral palsy, the Nebraska native has done so much more than simply accept his disability: he has become a symbol for extraordinary effort to achieve what no one believed he could. On crutches, he made his way up Pikes Peak three times, skied Colorado's mountains, competed in 28 marathons, as well as jogged 3,528 miles from San Francisco's Golden Gate Bridge to New York's Brooklyn Bridge. And these milestones came after Traylor endured 14 surgeries, years of therapy and painful braces during his childhood.

"If I didn't have these crutches, I'd be handicapped. They are the symbol of my mobility, my ability," he said.

Facing life's challenges requires courage, a positive outlook, and the ability to pick yourself up and carry on when you don't think it's possible.

"Some people never get on the starting line. Get on that starting line and do your best!" he said. "Embrace the race with joy... You (<http://www.joy...You>) grow by participating, by being there."

In addition to speaking to student in two assemblies, Traylor arrived early to meet with individuals and small groups, ate lunch with students, and made himself available to anyone who wanted to talk.

"I liked his message that there are no limits and that you can succeed in anything if you try," sophomore Christine Kearsley said after the assembly.

For Tanner Stark, a junior, the takeaway thought was "to keep moving forward and don't let anything hold you back."

This type of assembly reinforces the goal of graduating well-rounded students, Estes Park High School principal Chuck Scott said after the presentation. "The opportunity to bring someone like this in helps us reach some kids that we can't," he added.

Scott expressed gratitude to the three Estes Park Rotary clubs for their collaboration on a grant that funded Traylor's day in the school district.

"His goal is to build community within the school, and the time he spent with kids after his presentations is what will make a difference," noted Brad Rosenbaum, Noon Rotary Club president.

Kristi Faraguna, Sunrise Rotary president, and Marcy Predmore, Longs Peak President, agreed Faraguna appreciated Traylor's advice to the students on how to handle bullies.

"I loved his message that we're all different and that's good," Predmore said.
