Project Title: MCV Foster Homes Rebuild

Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?
 Financed the rebuilding of seven orphan foster family homes destroyed by floods in the Malawi Children's Village area, Mangochi District of Southern Malawi, Africa. The cost of a permanent and upgraded village house is \$700USD. This \$5000 Rotary Foundation grant (\$2500 from Palmer Rotary Club and \$2500 match from Rotary District 5010) bought building materials and paid for the labor to complete seven new homes. A 5 member team from the Palmer, Alaska Rotary Club traveled to Malawi the week of May 22, 2016 to assist in starting the construction of two houses, helping lay bricks and other related basic construction support. At the end of the team's visit, all seven of the constructed homes were visited and the home's new owners/orphan guardian met.

2. How many people benefited from this project? Directly: 15 orphans & guardians directly, plus many extended family members

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?
 The elderly guardians, usually a grandparent or extended family member and the student age orphans themselves, and many village extended family members. Permanent weather resistant & long lasting housing was provided to the guardian and orphan, and other related household children who had previously had to live in very crowded living conditions of other villagers. Adequate shelter and disaster recovery were the primary humanitarian needs met...but all material and labor used to build the homes were secured locally, so positive economic and community development ramifications were supported as well.

4. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Directly: 7

5. What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project.
 Direct coordination/facilitation for team travel preparation and on-site construction assistance.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?
 Malawi Children's Village... provider of a continuum of services for over 2000 orphans and their guardians. MCV provided all the preliminary identification/prioritizing of the families to receive new homes, and in directing and securing all materials and labor for home constructions. Facilitated and provided all the logistical support for the visiting Rotarian Team to assist in construction.


