Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

The project was to add to the number of \$500 dollar international summer study abroad scholarships and allow us to add one \$1000 dollar scholarship for first-year university study. The Rotary club routinely gives 4 international summer study abroad scholarships with this grant we were able to add 2 more. The club also gives 5 first-year scholarships and this grant allowed us to add 1 additional. This project originated in Stephenville, Texas but will be realized in Colombia, Mexico, Kenya and in 4 separate Texas Universities.

Four club members were on the selection committee for the international study abroad program scholars. Eight+ members were involved in the planning, arranging and direction of our Leaders of Tomorrow Banquet, where the university scholarships were awarded.

Tarleton State University administered, monitored and conducted the program for the 6 international study abroad students.
