We provided school supplies and backpacks for disadvantaged students in Wickenburg and the surrounding area. The students received their supplies at the CAP (Community Action Program) in Wickenburg, July 23, with approximately 20 Rotarians present.

Each student is equipped to arrive at school on day 1 on an equal playing field with all the other students. They are provided with the amount of supplies necessary for them to begin a great school year.

Wickenburg School District provides us with the names of the needy students, purchases the supplies and provides the staging area to put together the backpacks. Then the CAP office provides the pick up area, and helps distribute.


