Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?
 With the lead of Community Service Chair, Chris Gray, Anchorage South Rotary in collaboration with Anchorage Hillside Rotary constructed, painted, installed and filled 22 Little Free Libraries around the Anchorage community. We started the progress in early to mid-Aug and all construction and painting was completed by early Sept. On Nov. 9th the majority of the libraries were installed by 17 club members from both clubs on a very brisk morning, we also received the support of a group of cub scouts. Libraries were filled that day when installed and have been assigned to members to monitor for damage and keeping books in stock. The signs were placed on the libraries on January 3rd.

 The 22 different Little Free Libraries benefit various age groups in the community as the books appeal to various demographics and ages and are helping to increase literacy across our community. It is anticipated that each library benefits 50 people per area.


