**Project Description**

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

The Senior Center in La Paz County has an existing transportation service that provides services for senior citizens within the county who do not have access to reliable transportation. With limited funding, the Director of the Senior Center has been able to provide some transportation for Veterans to receive medical care outside of the immediate area. The grant provided by Rotary increased services and area of mobility for medical appointments for Vets.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Volunteered for any shifts needed for assisting with the transportation of Veterans to and from medical appointments. Assisted with recruiting of any veterans who may benefit from transportation services to and from medical facilities.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Veterans having the ability to receive medical services at VA clinics in Arizona which are not in the immediate area. Traveling area for services may include round trip approximate mileage of 300 miles. Increase opportunity for Veterans who may not have had access to reliable transportation for medical services.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Cooperating organization was mainly responsible for oversight of funds used, maintaining accurate records of expenses, provide transportation to and from medical facilities, track use of services, and maintain modes of transportation. Currently the grant has been able to assist in support of 45 rides, with over 11,000 miles traveled.


