 Project Title: Hostetler Park Rejuvenation (Victims for Justice)

Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?

Hostetler Park provides a place for victims and their surviving relatives to commemorate their lives and reflect on hope and healing for the future. This project will rejuvenate the existing memorial, relocate the "tree of life" to the park from a spot on the Park Strip about 1/2 mile away, and expand the purpose from just memorial to also inspiration for a more positive future.

2. How many people benefited from this project? Entire Anchorage Community, +200,000

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?

The over 100 victims and families currently memorialized will get a revitalized monument along with a more inviting setting to support their recovery from a violent attack. This park, in conjunction with our partners work on education, will promote a greater degree of social peace in the community and educate our youth on the risks of violence and bullying, and educate the youth on ways to work forward without resorting to violence.

4. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 20

Formed a committee to design the work needed to rejuvenate the park and bring together existing memorials and combined into a new monument; solicited the involvement of the Municipality and the Parks Foundation, and coordination with the group Victims for Justice who maintains the Park. Additionally, they worked together to solicit the matching funds needed to successfully match the District Grant Funds, as well as publicize the changes underway for this park and its purpose.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Rotary Club of Anchorage work in collaboration with the Municipality of Anchorage and the Parks Foundation; we coordinated the allocation of duties, design of the project, distribution of funds, and designation of contractors to do the work.


