Project Description

- Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?
 Recreational trail was built on Near Island In July and August 2016. Near Island is 276 acres within Kodiak city limits. It combines scenic coast and timber features with a commercial fishing boat harbor, float plane base, and fisheries research facilities.

- Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?
 People using readily accessible trails for recreation. Anecdotally, these include families with young children, tourists; and people who are physically unable or do not have time to use more challenging trails. This trail allows an accessible wilderness-like experience. Also, the Kodiak High School track team was able to attend cross country training camp in Montana by as compensation for their labor to build the trail. This project has become a model leading to further collaborative efforts between ITN and supporting organizations to continue trail construction. Rotary funded only part of the trail that was built by ITN.
- How many Rotarians participated in the project? 6

 Island Trails Network (ITN) is a non-profit organization in Kodiak Island Borough. Three Rotarians are on ITN's board providing governance to ITN planning and oversight to the Trail project and Rotarians assist through school administration. Rotarians provide assistance with publicity.
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?
 Cooperating organizations are: The Noon and Morning Rotary clubs in Kodiak; the Kodiak Island Trails Network who are responsible for an extensive network of Kodiak Island trails; and, the Kodiak High School cross country track team who under the supervision of their faculty coach performed the construction.
