- 3. Briefly describe your project (who did what, when and where did project activities take place?) in 100 words or less. Rand Bergstrom along with the workers at Global Vision Farm purchased and installed a Diesel Water pump, along with 3inch PVC pipe lines to help provide irrigation to an additional 8 acres of Vision Farm during the two dry seasons during the year. In addition, 800 (300 more than projected) mango trees were purchased and planted as part of this Rotary project at Vision Farm just outside of Mirebalais, Haiti.
- 4. In one brief sentence: who were the beneficiaries of the grant activities and how many of them were there? There are multiple beneficiaries: First, The children and staff at All God's Children's Orphanage, a ministry of Global Vision Citadelle Ministries are the primary beneficiaries of the food raised at Vision Farm. There are 130 children and an additional 35 workers and staff. Second, there are currently 11 men employed as laborers at Vision Farm, thus helping provide jobs in a struggling economy. Third, it is projected that in another two years, Vision Farm will be producing surplus fruit and vegetables, which will benefit both GVCM to help pay the workers and provide opportunity for local members of the community to purchase produce wholesale from GVCM Vision Farm, to sell the produce at local markets and earn income.
- 5. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Andy Morris, Chaplain at the Gooding club participated in organization of this project, both stateside and on-site. Andy has worked with Rand for planning and communicating in the states for GVCM Vision Farm, as well as follow-up and support in Haiti and with Public Relations and Reports. In addition, the Gooding club's Sergeant at Arms, Chris Comstock's wife, son and daughter have visited and helped work on developing projects at GVCM Vision Farm in March of 2014 and 2016.
- 6. If a cooperating organization(s) other than the beneficiary was involved, what was its role? Gooding First Christian has been a primary participant in establishing GVCM Vision Farm since 2014, both financially and in planning and promoting and developing sustainable Permaculture and methodology at Vision Farm with the end goal of reducing the monthly costs of food at All God's Children's Orphanage.
