Your club must have ESP. We were completely out of water and had it on our ever lengthy "to do" list for next week. We get lots of donated water after and during large extended fires, but it is needed year round. We have been working an average of 2 to 3 wrecks per month in recent months mainly on Hwy. 281. We actually go through quite a bit of water on wrecks taking between two to four hours to clear a scene. The increased speed limit, increased traffic, and texting is literally killing us.

Since I live closer to the fire station than to the post office, I thought to hand-deliver the Walmart card this morning. And I had the chance to visit with Chief Jimmy Chew, whom I have known for many years.

He was grateful for the gift card and asked that I give the club his thanks. I don't know how you, Richard, will count that on your grid, but it was a "thank you" in behalf of both Stephenville stations.

Jimmy also said the gift card was an especially good idea. Walmart will usually give the fire departments a better price than the club can get. And, he can get bottles of water when they are needed; so that they don't sit around in the open and go bad from prolonged exposure to the plastic.

He also said that in the entire county the only sites I would be likely to locate are in Stephenville and Dublin. The others, he said, only come in--to often hard to find garages--in an emergency or if someone decides to work on the equipment. He offered to get me the contact information on the other departments by next week.

And, he said that in January he becomes head of the state fire chiefs association with access to all the departments in all the counties. If we decide to do this project again, and give him a couple of weeks notice, he will provide contact information for whatever recipients we choose. Hardly any have mailing addresses, and calling the number in the telephone book might set off an emergency response unnecessarily.

I'll drive over to Dublin tomorrow and wait for Jimmy to give me the information on the other locations/contacts.
