Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done? Rotary Youth Exchange conducted the annual outbound orientation for students and their parents from Districts 5630 and 5650. This is our opportunity to acquaint participant families to Rotary International and the Youth Exchange Program. Our goal is to ensure families feel confident in their student's exchange plans and the process they are heading into. The weekend also includes activities and presentations by the hosted inbound students from both districts, as well as Rotex-mentors, and Rotarians. In all, 11 hosted (inbound) students, 19 sponsored (outbound) students, 9 Rotex-mentors and 15 Rotarians participated in the activities. Various community service, cultural and recreational activities and an overnight stay were included in the weekend.

Experienced exchange students and host parents, Rotarians and current exchange students shared words of wisdom and answered questions throughout the day sessions. During the evening and overnight, new outbound students were able to glean from discussions with inbound students and experienced exchange students. 
