3. Briefly describe your project :

Beneficiaries:

This project was to complete the concrete pours necessary to complete the flag plaza around the American flag in the center of the St. Anthony Rotary Park. Two concrete pours were made in mid and late July, 2016 that completed the outer ring in the circular flag plaza at Rotary Park,

The beneficiaries were the 3,000 citizens of St. Anthony and also visitors to the City.

How many Rotarians participated in the project?

The on-ground work (to form and finish the concrete) was supervised by Rotarian Bob

Bauer, with the help of four other Rotarians and four local volunteers (a total of 16.5 hours for the Rotarians and 16.5 hours for the volunteers). The volunteers included a local concrete contractor who donated his time to make sure the concrete was formed and poured correctly.

6. If a cooperating organization(s) other than the beneficiary was involved, what was its role?

The City of St. Anthony is a cooperating organization. They provided people from the parks department to assure the project was constructed to city standards and the City will maintain the park in the future.
