The Torrington Rotary Club paid for termite repairs and the tear out and replacement of worn and damaged flooring in the Land of Goshen Ministries Thrift Store in Torrington, Wyoming The beneficiaries will be the citizens who frequent the Thrift Store as customers or volunteers and ultimately the 130 families who receive food and support from the store.
