## Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

This project was to provide security lighting to the McCook Skate Park with the purchase of one light pole and light, as well as man power of one of our Rotary Club members. The project was to be completed in November of 2016. However, it was found that additional work needed to be completed at the Skate Park by the City of McCook because fall storms flooded the area and caused damage to the park. The City implemented a new landscape addition to alter the water away from the skate bowl instead of into the bowl. This pushed back the purchase of the lighting as the City was not sure where the lighting would go until the new landscaping was finished. In May 2017, the light pole was ordered and purchased using \$1,000 of McCook Rotary funds as well as \$1,000 of funds from Rotary District 5630.

2. How many people benefited from this project? Approximately 200+ skaters from McCook and surrounding area

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?

Beneficiaries of this project are approximately 200+ skaters from the McCook and surrounding area who participate in skating activities, along with anyone who walks around the skate park. The skate park is in a very dim lit part of time as it is surrounded by trees with now lighting once the sun sets. The addition of the security lighting brings safety and well-being to the community by providing a well-lit place for children and adults to play.
