Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Verde Valley Habitat for Humanity volunteers evaluate the homeowners needs, design the ramps, create a bill of materials, submit request purchase to VVHFH to acquire materials. Three wheel chair ramp builds have been completed as of 6/19/17. The last two are scheduled to be completed by the end of July 2017. The homeowners are the Barber's, J. Allert, A. Grubb, L. Cherry, and I. Ortega. These homeowners live in Cottonwood and Camp Verde.

Rotarian volunteers moved materials, helped measure and saw wood, hammered nails and used screws to attach wood pieces to build ramp sections. Onsite, they helped to put the modular sections together using nails and screws.

These homeowners live at very low income levels, and due to a lack of care resources are living in their homes longer. By having the means to safely come and go from their homes, the homeowners feel they still have their independence, by having less dependence on outside resources, and an improved quality of life

Rotary Club of the Verde Valley - provided volunteers to help with construction.
Verde Valley Habitat for Humanity organized the home repair and wheel chair ramp program and the volunteers to lead the program.
