1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? **We partnered with Sunview Elementary School this year and provided grades Pre-K through 5<sup>th</sup> grade 2 books per student for summer reading. In addition we provided 10 Chrome notebooks to enhance their hands-on classroom experience.**
2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? **30**
3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. **Out of our 37 members, 30 participated in the project.**
  - **The books were assembled during our regular meetings on April 11<sup>th</sup> and April 13<sup>th</sup> to present to our students. Each book has a sticker placed inside with the Sunview Logo stating that the books were donated by Huntington Beach Rotary.**
  - **The books are then wrapped together using ribbon and include a book mark with the “4 Way Test” in each set.**
  - **Then we had another 10 Rotarians actually go to the school to hand out the books on April 25<sup>th</sup>. The students were called into small assemblies where Rotarians actually read stories to the kids before handing the books out.**
4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? **Every student at Sunview Elementary School benefitted from this project as 100% were given books to take home as their own for reading. The families of those students also benefit in reading together and sharing with siblings at home.**
5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? **Reading by 9! Our hope is to keep them engaged in the fun of reading. These students are from a low socio-economic area and do not have funds for an extra reading program.**

**By giving the children books and reading to them we hope that they will continue to be inspired to continue to learn.**
