The dictionary project was approved by TRF as a reallocation of funds from our greenbelt signage project that we couldn't complete due to delays beyond club control. The clubs bought and distributed student dictionaries to third graders and their teachers in the Treasure Valley. Members delivered them to the classrooms and made presentations about the dictionaries and what Rotary does for the community. In the fall and spring of 2016-17 the clubs delivered to the following schools: Anser Academy, Eagle Hills, Eagle Elementary, Galileo STEM, North Star Charter, Seven Oaks, Rolling Hills Charter, Pierce Park, Shadow Hills, Star, White Pine, Horizon, Andrus, Valley View, Hillcrest, Amity, Maple Grove, Monroe, Owyhee-Harbor, Idaho City, Cole Valley and Idaho Distance Education.
