Hi Ken,

I'm hoping to have your approval to change the projects for 3 clubs in our 2016-17 block grant. The clubs are Boise Metro, Boise Centennial and Eagle-Garden City. In a joint project for interpretive signs on the Boise Greenbelt, each of the three clubs received \$1235 from DG1743261. Much to our dismay, the City of Boise has fallen behind on completing the greenbelt project; hence, the clubs are unable to complete the signage before the two-year completion deadline. District 5400 issued a grant check of DDF on Aug. 15, 2016 for the project. May we approve these clubs to change their grant to the Dictionary Project, providing dictionaries to elementary students in local schools? The dictionary projects were conducted in the 2016-17 Rotary year. Some funds may yet need to be returned to TRF, but all would not be lost for these clubs who chose to pursue a larger project over their dictionaries at the time of application.
