2. Supplies for Teachers
3. We contacted the teachers of the three school districts that are in our immediate area:
Mountain Home School District, Glenns Ferry School District, and Grand View Bruneau School District. We asked them what supplies they needed for the kids and when they needed them. We then took the provided list and shopped for the requested items and delivered them to the schools. The Mountain Home District requested a food bank for the students at Bennett Mountain High School, basic supplies , emergency clothing and personal hygiene supplies, and basic first aid supplies including lice treatment products. Glenns Ferry requested clothing and personal hygiene items. Grand View requested science equipment for their STEM program.
4. These supplies benefited the students in three districts – 500 plus kids
5. Two people did the majority of the shopping while 5 others were responsible for contacting the schools and delivering the supplies. Other club members made donations of food and money to support the food bank
