Project Description:

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were involved?

The Casper Reveille Rotary Club purchased and assembled three metal park benches to be placed along the Long Drainage Path in Casper, WY. The path abuts a senior assisted living facility and more than 300 market rate apartments. The club members installed the forms for two of the benches. The Casper Parks Department staff poured the concrete for the pads and bolted down the benches. Rotary was not charged for the concrete or labor. The third bench was installed in September of 2018 in Long Park once a sidewalk replacement project was completed.

They assembled three metal benches, and installed the forms needed to pour the concrete pads for two of the benches
