1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
This grant provided funding for the construction of storage racks for new kayaks we obtained to support our monthly Back Bay clean-up project. The racks are located at the Newport Aquatic Center, Newport Beach Ca. Beneficiaries include our partners The Newport Aquatic Center, The Back Bay Conservancy, UCI Rotaract Club and our monthly volunteers.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Ten Rotarians participated in the project.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.
They helped with securing the grant and funding, the construction of the kayak racks, and with our monthly Back Bay clean-ups.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Our entire club benefitted through the community services provided, the recognition we have received and with the fellowship activities accrued at each monthly clean-up.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? We have collected 10 tons of debris over the past four years that accumulates in the Upper Newport Bay, particularly after storms occur. Keeping the harbor attractive and helping support this important wildlife sanctuary greatly benefits the local community. In addition, our volunteers (particularly Interactors and Rotaractors) are educated in water safety and environmental impacts of storm drainage systems.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? The Back Bay Conservancy received a grant to purchase the kayaks that we use. The Newport Aquatic Center provides the site for the racks and kayaks.


