Brief Project Description:

Mission Viejo Rotary has sponsored the Door of Faith Orphanage in Mexico since 1988. We have been in constant communication with the Orphanage throughout the years with various projects and were informed by the District staff at Rotary Foundation training that a participating Mexican Club would not be necessary. With over 115 children and 20 voluntary staff the kitchen is in dire need of a new oven/range and low burners for large pots (cost \$3,200). They are also in need of two mashing machines with as many as thirty loads of done daily (cost \$1,600). In addition the children are required to wear uniforms including dress shoes in order to attend school and church (cost \$3,048)
