On December 12 our Rotary Club was happy to host our 27th Annual Vocational Day at the Capistrano Unified School District Board Room. The purpose of the day is to bring in high school seniors from the district and have presentations and table top discussion with speakers and seasoned career professionals from all sectors to share their career path.				
How many Rotarians participated in the project? 30 Rotarians participated				
3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Each Rotarian was assigned a table along with a career professional. They facilitated discussion around career paths and life successes. There were an average of 8 students per table and they self-selected the table topic.				
 How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? The number of attendees in addition to the 30 Rotarians were: 120 students (from 3 different high schools in the district), 2 keynote speakers, 6 career professionals and 10 of the School District staff. 				
5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Community impact is the collaboration between the Rotary Club, the School District and the community at large to work with these students to help them think through their next steps in life through the eyes of many different career professionals. 21 careers were represented which gave the students a great picture of what their path could be.				
6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? The Capistrano Unified School District offered the space at no cost. The Culinary Arts Class from Aliso Niguel High School prepared the breakfast and snacks for the day. There were two keynote speakers that kicked off the morning; Jim Madrid and Ms. Tina Aldatz.
