Brief Project Description:

Implementation of a new aspect to the provision of emergency services to families in temporary financial hardship - provision of hygiene and health products as required in addition to food.

Families who are experiencing a temporary bad time financially for various reasons may require temporary food and hygiene support. This is designed so that both parents and children are well nourished, but also able to take care of fundamental hygiene issues properly as well. The Yorba Linda Food Bank is now an officially recognized EFAP agency, i.e. an Emergency Food Assistance Program agency. Our financial contributions are used to acquire food

We are able to acquire food and hygiene products at significant discounts from the Second Harvest Food Bank and also from suppliers locally such as Stater Brothers and Smart& Final.

Stater Brothers, Smart & Final supply products at significant discount for the service.

Families with children who have fallen on temporary tough times financially. The family and especially the children are kept nourished, which ensure better health and ability to focus at school. We now ensure hygiene products to further assist and prevent health problems.
