Yorba Linda Sunrise Rotary club members assist with packaging and delivery of food and hygiene products to families in need, through the Food for Families program.. The club provides funds and participates in association with the leaders to purchase food from Second Harvest and other low cost providers.

Rotarians physically repack shelves with food as required, when goods are delivered, or collected from the suppliers.
Rotarians assist the other volunteers to package food for families in need, paying attention to specific needs, example children versus infants needs.

Currently we have assisted more than 250 persons this Rotary year. We typically assist between 250 to 300 persons, with an emphasis on children.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?
No child goes hungry during the time of economic crisis for a family. This means they are able to attend school and to study, which has long term benefits to the children, the family and the community.

Yorba Linda Food for Families and their volunteers.
