Most members of the club will be present at the distribution center at the day of the giveaway and will setup and clean up the room. We expect 13-15 members for a total of 170 hours.

We are serving low income children ages 5-18 from the City of Santa Fe Springs. Many of these children live in households that are unable to afford basic school supplies. The city has set income criteria guidelines to screen children in order to identify those who are most in need.

The need in this community is great. Although only 17,000 people are residents of Santa Fe Springs, 26% of them are under the age of 18. 9% of people in this city live below the poverty line according to the US Census Bureau. In order for kids of these families to breakout of the cycle of poverty, it is imperative for them to have the resources necessary to succeed in school which will create opportunities that were not available to their families.  Please note that the city of Santa Fe Springs will donate \$3,500 to this project and will also provide some staff.
