## Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

We purchased a magnificent 4-sided clock that was installed in a prominent location on Main Street in the City of Grapevine to celebrate the 50 years of service that the Grapevine Rotary Club has given to the city and to the world. The clock will be viewed by everyone who visits the city and will serve as a permanent memorial to the extensive and outstanding service that Rotarians here have given to make this world a better place.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? At least 60

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Rotarians researched all the major clock manufacturers to find the best possible outside clock, applied for a district grant, worked with the city staff and city council to determine which clock design would best fit the historic character of the city and to decide on the best possible location. Two presentations were made to the City Council. The city installed the clock and has agreed to maintain it. A dedication ceremony, held on a date close to the original first meeting of the GRC, was attended by the entire GRC, the District Governor, the Mayor and the City Council.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Thousands now & into the future

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

The clock serves as a focal point for visitors and citizens alike and all who read the plaque will understand the wonderful service that Rotary has provided to the city and to the world.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

The city staff and city officials were involved in every aspect of selecting the clock, its location, its installation and the city will provide the maintenance for the future.
