1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?  
 Idaho has the nations lowest per capita rate for women getting mammograms. The project is designed to provide education and awareness to the English and Spanish speaking communities in Teton Valley Idaho. A series of "Pink Teas" will be presented in the month of May, 2017.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?  
 Teton Valley Club members equal 7 and Star Valley equal 4.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.  
 Teton Valley members organized location, advertising, speakers, and refreshments. Star Valley communicated with Teton Valley and presented the idea of Breast Cancer awareness to the club.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?  
 There is an anticipated participation of 100 to 120 guests for the two Pink Teas.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?  
 1 out of 9 women will be diagnosed with breasts cancer. Over time, the numbers could reach 10 to 15 women's lives saved.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?  
 The Huntsman Springs Resort located in Driggs, Idaho has agreed to wave their \$500 use fee for the Teas. Also, the Teton Valley Healthcare Foundation provided funds for screenings. The Hispanic Resource Center has also agreed to wave use fees for their Tea. The Hispanic Resource Center tea is scheduled for May 5 and the Huntsman Springs Resort Tea is scheduled for May 25. The In kind contributions from the community equal \$1717.00.
