Project Description:

1. Briefly describe the project. What was or will be done and where did or will the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were or will be involved? Idaho is the lucky state to rank lowest in women who receive mammograms. Our hospital has funding to provide free basic mammograms but education is the key. The Teton Valley Rotary Club will be hosting a high tea on Thursday, May 25. They will do newspaper advertizing and social media to advertise the project, along with flyers, and they will host the event at Huntsman Springs Resort. The tie to the Huntsman Cancer Institute would be great. They will have both male and female cancer survivors talk. The Teton Valley Hospital Foundation actually has fake breasts with every kind of cancer tumor in it that will be used to teach women how to properly check breasts. Then they will start scheduling mammograms there.

They will also be working with the Hispanic Resource Center to do the same presentation in Spanish at their facility. The plan is to bring the same foods and teas or even do something more in line with the Hispanic culture. They are contacting both and hope to do this on May 11.
