Laurel Elementary School Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) is a non-profit organization made up of parent and teacher volunteers. Our goal is to support our students, parents, teachers, and the school as a whole. This year we really need your help! Our 5th graders at Laurel Elementary School have an exciting opportunity to attend Camp Cuyamaca Outdoor School April 24th - 28th. This will be the first time in over a decade that students from Laurel will attend \(5^{\text {th }}\) grade camp.

Laurel Elementary is a Title I school and our students come from a variety of diverse backgrounds, including military. Over ninety-six percent of our students are low-income families and qualify for free and reduced lunch. Unfortunately, many of our students face highly challenging situations in their home environments including domestic violence, single parent household, drug \& alcohol abuse, food insecurity, multiple families living in small quarters, gang affiliations and influence, and many other emotionally difficult situations. Camp Cuyamaca is an amazing opportunity for our students to experience a completely different environment, to take them away from the challenging situations they live with daily. This could be a trip of a lifetime for our students.

Camp Cuyamaca is a five-day overnight education experience, which connects school children with science and nature. The activities our students will participate in aim to nourish their appreciation of nature, create a deeper understanding of science concepts, and provide an opportunity for them to explore their independence in a safe, educational and fun environment. Cuyamaca Outdoor School, operated by the San Diego County Office of Education (SDCOE), is the only outdoor education program in San Diego County featuring credentialed teachers and a curriculum aligned with the Next Generation Science Standards and Common Core State Standards.

This is where we need your help. The cost of this trip is approximately \(\$ 328.00\) per student. Regrettably, for many of our families this is simply unattainable. The \(\$ 328.00\) includes all lodging, meals, transportation, and class materials.
