1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

The objective of the Grant was to give painting materials (art packs with water color, brush, crayons, and paper (Att.1)) to kids for art therapy. Our collaborating partner Art4Kids has received \$3000 (Attachments 2 and 3) and has delivered 450 art packs & guidance to the following organizations:

- 1. Family Assistance Ministries (FAM) 345 art packs (Attachment 4)
- 2. Project Hope Alliance 50 art packs
- 3. Inland Valley Recovery Services 35 art packs
- 4. Laura's House 20 art packs

The beneficiaries of the art therapy are children of families, who are receiving assistance from the above organizations.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

8 Rotarians

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Six Rotarians (see photos Att.3a-f) distributed 300 art packs during **FAM's** Thanksgiving Dinner on 11/23/2016 in San Clemente, where over 500 meals were served (see photos Att.4a-e). Other Rotarians selected the organizations receiving the art packs. The Principle Contact for the District Grant participated at the booth of Art4Kids (see photos Att.7a and b) at **Camp HeART**, held at the Santa Ana Zoo on 3/18/2017 and organized by the Children Abuse Prevention Center. This organization emphasizes art expression as means of overcoming trauma of abuse. It was a special experience for the Rotarian to see kids enjoy expressing their feelings through painting and making collages in a safe and caring environment (photos 7c to 7g).

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

In the FAM and Camp HeART projects the wives of the Rotarians participated and interacted with the children. Also, the staff of above organizations realized the positive impact of art therapy on kids experiencing trauma.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

The hope is that the parents realize the important of art therapy for their kids overcoming adversity and continue art therapy at home.
