Dear Fullerton Rotary Main,

On behalf of all of us at OC United and the young men in our program, I want to thank you for your generous contribution to our **T.H.R.I.V.E.** (Transitional **H**omes **R**ecognizing **I**ndependence **V**alue and **E**mpowerment) home for aged-out foster youth. Our holistic program offers youth who age-out of the foster care system a supportive environment along with necessary skills to equip them to succeed independently. Our solution includes: life skills training, mentor families, quality therapy, GED or college assistance, job training, spiritual development, budget coaching, and affordable housing.

Fullerton Rotary Main's \$3000 matching district grant authorized \$6,000 to be used toward furnishing our new home. Due to Rotary's contribution and our partnerships with Living Spaces and Custom Comfort, we purchased seven Captain's beds (with storage drawers underneath and bookcase headboards), six mattresses, living room and dining room furniture.
