1389 new shoe pairs were distributed to impoverished children near and in the city of Medellin Colombia. 310 were Crock-like style shoes and 1079 were tennis-like school shoes. The average cost of shoes distributed is \$5.96 per pair. The NGO Shoes to the World added an additional \$334.93 to be able to provide shoes to all the children of the final and much needed last distribution. These new shoes replaced worn out shoes that in most cases were ill-fitting and fungus/bacteria ridden.

Del Mar Solana Beach Rotary with help from Host Rotary Medellin El Poblado and NGO Shoes to the World, we were able to reach children in remote areas that strengthened love and affection shown through the gift of shoes from total strangers. The children were elated to have their first pair of new shoes! Their self-confidence was built by the thought that total strangers would place such value on them to give them a brand new pair of shoes, and the ones that received school shoes realized the importance that total strangers placed in their education to make sure they had the shoes required to attend school. Every child received and gave a hug. They were made aware this was a gift of love! This love from strangers called "Rotarians" is what the lessons learnt.
