 - A) Two teacher selected students (one boy and one girl) with perfect attendance records at Thornton Elementary School in Arlington ISD were rewarded each six-week period with tablets at an award ceremony held at the school.
 - B) This program also assisted with feeding the students and teachers on an early dismissal day in December where many of the students would not have had access to a meal that day. Numerous Rotarians showed up to cook and serve hot dog lunches to students and teachers at Thornton Elementary School.
 - C) This program also provided for manufacturing of new soccer goals and new accessories for Thornton Elementary that was identified as a great need for the students.
