The Rotary Club of Fallbrook addressed the needs of a 10th grader named Mariana Torres Cruz. By supporting Mariana with a \$600 scholarship we helped provide her with a school uniform, bus transportation, registration fees, books and school supplies. She also participated in Project Amigo's Homework Club which encourages setting career goals and planning for the future.

It is always easier to fund a project when there is contact with the person or place. We had several Rotarians who were so impressed by a speaker from Project Amigo that they travelled there to help in person.
