This grant supported the Coronado Rotary Club RYLA 2017 program that resulted in 13 high school juniors (7 from Coronado High School and 6 from Mar Vista High School in Imperial Beach) attending camp. One additional student from Mar Vista attended as an alternate funded by another club.

The current program is cumbersome. Also, requests for receipts, checks and so forth preceded the actual event. I find it challenging and I'm pretty good at using web sites.
