Due to backorder of selected books, all but 2 of the 6 classroom visits have been completed. Remaining 2 classes will be completed by 5/15/17 or sooner depending on delivery of remaining books.

Last year we ordered the same book for every student/class. This year we learned ordering 3-4 different books gives the kids an opportunity to share and/or swap which they liked. Prior to this grant our club didn't begin working with students until they got to 3rd grade and received a dictionary. The earlier we get to them, the better.




