1. Matching funds for this project came from the Community Rotaract Club (\$500), Rotary Club of Cheyenne (\$500), Sunrise Rotary Club (\$500) and Afterhours Rotary Club (\$500).
2. The Planning Team discussed the project through email and an in-person meeting on February 8, 2017.
3. The Chemo Care Package Supplies were ordered from Walmart, Dollar Tree, Specialty Incentives and Starbucks.
4. The Packages were filled at the District 5440 Interact Spring Assembly on April 29th.
5. In addition to the Interact District Assembly attendees, ALL three Rotary Clubs (Sunrise, Noon, Afterhours), two Rotaract Clubs (Community, LCCC) and three Interact Clubs (Central, East, Triumph) helped fill the packages.
6. The packages will be delivered to the Cancer Center over the next year and will be given to all new cancer patients.

The Rotary, Rotaract and Interact Clubs filled 180 Rotary themed bags with supplies for cancer patients. The bags will be delivered to new cancer patients as they start treatment.


