3. Briefly describe the grant and list any changes that might have occurred (100 words or less)
 - I. EDUCATIONAL PROJECT-Rotary Club of San Diego South Bay provides Student's Desks and Chairs to Barotac Nuevo Elementary School, currently the desks are worn out, some are without back rests due to being over 60 yrs. old. We also provide 6 computers, printer, and projector to be used by students and teachers. For the economically disadvantaged students, the school will be the only place they can have the opportunity to use the computer. There is growing evidence that technology integration positively affects student's achievement and academic performance.
 - II. CLEAN WATER IMPROVEMENT- The Deep Well was drilled and funded by the Government of Canada (+NGO) a year after Typhoon Yolanda hit in Nov 2013. They provided a water tank and installed pipes to distribute water to three buildings including a toilet facility. The group also built a new building for classroom use and repaired other damaged buildings. However, they were not able to connect three buildings to water source due to shortage of funds. In less than two years the pump motor failed and the pipes installed developed leaks. Due to the said failure, the school decided to use a borrowed pump motor. With the help of this grant for Aglosong Elementary School, the damaged plumbing materials were replaced caused by typhoon Haiyan/Yolanda, and improved distribution of clean water within school campus. Replaced leaking existing pipes from water tank to classrooms to improve flow and save water, installed pipes to 3 new distribution points. Built/installed one wash station by outdoor common area. Built/installed two outdoor water fountains. Painted wash station and water fountains foundation to protect from element.

Educational project: We learned that the integration of technology to the school's curriculum improves the student's learning processes. This will engage both teachers and students in problem solving using these powerful tools. Clean Water Improvement: We learned that the purpose of this project is to improve the existing clean water distribution system in school campus (Aglosong Elementary School).


