In 2017 the Loveland Rotary Club Foundation graciously gifted Angel House, a program of House of Neighborly Service in Loveland, a grant to be used for mattress purchases. The purchase of these mattresses was a critical need for the Angel House program that serves homeless children and their parents in the Thompson School District. Angel House received funds totaling \$2220.80 between two separate checks.


With these awards we purchased a total of 59 mattresses through Amazon. The first purchase was made on February 14, 2017 for 40 Intex Pillow Rest Raised Airbeds with Pillow and Electric Pump totaling \$1,599.60, order #: 111-4982392-8901861. The second purchase was made on June 14, 2017 for 19 Intex Comfort Plush Airbed with Built-In Electric Pump totaling \$629.09, order #: 114-7915590-8963450.
